- Common numbering (CCN) is a program that makes commonly shared curses among Washington State community and technical colleges have the same course number and title. Common courses are identifiable with an ampersand ('&') in the course number (e.g. ENGL& 101).
- 5 college units/credits = 1 high school credit
- Minimum Highline College grade to earn credit for high school is .7
