Running Start Fee Waiver & Textbook Assistance Application

The Running Start Fee Waiver and Textbook Assistance program waives applicable course fees not covered by the Running Start program and provides quarterly vouchers for required textbooks. To qualify, students must meet one of the criteria below within the past 5 years. Students only need to apply once; eligibility is valid for the duration of the student's enrollment in the Running Start program at Highline College. Eligible students are encouraged to apply at the initial time of enrollment for the maximum benefit. Fee waiver benefits are not applied retroactively for previous quarters attended.

Instructions: 1) Check one box which applies to you, 2) provide supporting documentation, and 3) submit this completed application and supporting documentation to Running Start at Highline College or through our <u>virtual drop-box</u>.
